BELGRADE BREAKS RECORDS

Belgrade will break all records when it comes to the number of participants, sport disciplines and volunteers at the Summer Universiade 2009 but also for the 10th World University Taekwondo Championship (from 17th to 20th of July 2009).

Young athletes and academics will gather together from 42 countries and more than 300 taekwondoka which is a record in 20 years long history of university sports under the patronage of FISU (World University Sport Federation).

-Technically we did everything we should do. This is one of four test events we are staging this year. We provided all preconditions both in technical and human resources and are convinced that everything will run at its very best. These competitions are an excellent opportunity for the organizers of Universiade Belgrade to exercise and test all resources as well as supporting logistics and organizational skills in order to be well prepared for what is waiting for us next year.

The record number of applied competitors proves that there is a big interest for University Championships which is an important sign before Universiade



2009 – said Sinisa Jasnica, General Director of UB 2009, President of the USSS and President of the World University Championships at FISU. – We expect that our competitors achieve significant results at the forthcoming Championships.

Support of the World Taekwondo Federation speaks in favor of the importance and quality of the University championships.

Based on the contract we signed with the Secretary General, Jin Suk Jang, we received donations in tatami, scoring lights as well as games management system. When it comes to us the

Championships may begin. First athletes from the USA and the Netherlands are already here. We are ready for the competition and we are sure that everything will be on the highest possible level, as we promised.

Ken Min, President of FISU Technical commission for Taekwondo, didn't hide his satisfaction with everything what has been done so far and with the host's preparations for the 10th Jubilee edition of the World University Championship.

I am thrilled with everything I had a chance to see in Belgrade. As a host you met all standards and even more than that. I never had doubts that Serbia and Belgrade will be successful. I have been cooperating with Sinisa Jasnica from the beginning. He has all the credits, because this competition is in Belgrade and that taekwondo is still on the programme of the Universiade – Ken Min said.

First test event, the World University Championship in Taekwondo, is the introduction to the biggest global sporting event in 2009.

Serbia introduced a completely new concept, approach and the way of handling things

at the World University Championships that is not strange because Mr. Jasnica is most responsible for this on both levels, national and international level, but also inside FISU.

Dragan Jovic, Vice-President of the Taekwondo Association of Serbia and Competition Director for this World University Championship in "Hala Sportova" expects this championship to overcome Valencia by its results.

Our wish is that next to the great organization we achieve great results on tatami as well. The team consists of the proven champions and promising new hopes from who we also expect great results. Although the Olympic Games are less than 30 days away, according to the list of applied competitors, in Belgrade we will have fighters and medal bearers, 10 of whom are golden medallists which speaks about the quality of the Competition – Dragan Jovic said.

-Our goal is to come to the competition with people who can achieve results and they showed that they can – Patrick Stevens The Netherlands team coach stated – the generation change is in the progress, quite a lot of good taekwondoka graduated their Universities which means they will not be able to participate anymore in student teams while it is still early for our excellent junior team to take part in competition for older generations. -Medals are my goal at every competition. It's very clear. I don't want anything less. I came to Belgrade with the same goal – Deborah Luiz said.

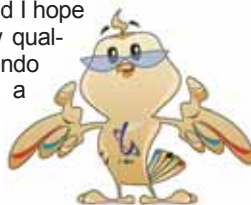
At World University Championships the old scoring system will be used, without the electronic protectors.

MEDAL IS NOT JUST A DREAM ANYMORE

Bojan Bjelić, the best Serbian taekwondo athlete, will defend the medal won in 2006 in Valencia on the jubilee World University Championship in Belgrade. He is the best hope of the Taekwondo Association of Serbia and Belgrade's Seagulls (Galeb). He won a golden medal on the Open Championship in Holland in February, which gave not only the historical results for Serbian sports but also announced also great results on the World University Championship in Serbian capital.

Valencia remained in nice memory. I invested great work during last years, it then paid off – said Bojan Bjelić, the hope of eagles in the category of 72 kilos – I had great day. I had very good start right from the first fight, but still the second fight

In the name of all my friends from the Serbian team I would like to say that we are ready for the next world challenge. We are in the phase of finishing preparations, for a month already. In the past months we had high amounts of the test competitions, this gives us additional confidence to show what we know and what we can do on the field of play. According to the schedule I'm competing on the first day I hope I will bring sport luck to our team – Bojan Bjelic stated.

was crucial for me, because I defeated the champion of the Universiade in Izmir.

In the Serbian representation, they don't hide the fact that Bjelić is one of their biggest aces in the sleeves, which is normal, because he literally crashed all his opponents on the Holland Open. He won first the Spaniard Anhel Mugnoz with a knock-out then the Englishmen Sebastian Mayer.

After the match, the English-

men came to me and congratulated me on the great fight. He wished me a lot of luck in my further carrier, which meant a lot to me in that moment – Bjelić was honest.

Bjelić doesn't hide that his stay in Iran has helped him a great deal in his carrier.

One-month stay in Teheran had positive influence on us, in psychical way in the first place. We are now full of self-confidence, what you can see in my fights but also in my matches with Marko Memarević, Stevan Rašić, Ninoslav Babić and Stanislav Kujundžić. If you look at the training methods, there are no revolutionary differences between Iranians and us. They have many sparring partners, a real army of great fighters and they are completely devoted to sport. There is no time for even one moment of relaxation when it comes to Iranians.

Good voice spreads fast and the news about great results of Bojan Bjelić came to the capital of Iran very quickly.

The coaches who worked with us on Azad University in Teheran had called me immediately to congratulate me. They have been telling us from the beginning that we have a great

potential and that medals are not just a dream. I am glad because I have won and justified their trust. However, I am even more glad because we will be their hosts on the World University Championship in Belgrade.

The path to the medal in Valencia and Eindhoven is not just the result of the good competition day, but the product of the systematic work.

I am glad that we in Galeb have a real professional team that takes care of us – we have conditional coach Dragan Jablan, psychologist Marija Srećkov, the people from Lama sport that provide us



with all the necessary vitamins, the nutritionist and off course coaches

Dragan Jović, Mario Lipsajt, Ljiljana Ljubojević, Uroš Todorović, Miloš Subotić. Will and

enthusiasm of Dragan Jović made their way to get to us even when our work has not been giving the wanted results. With the help of the entire team, I have managed to initiate, I hope, a whole range of excellent results of all of us in the representation. This is why I would like to thank in particular Dragan Jovic, all my friends from the club and the representation and my family – concluded Bjelić.

WELCOME TO BELGRADE

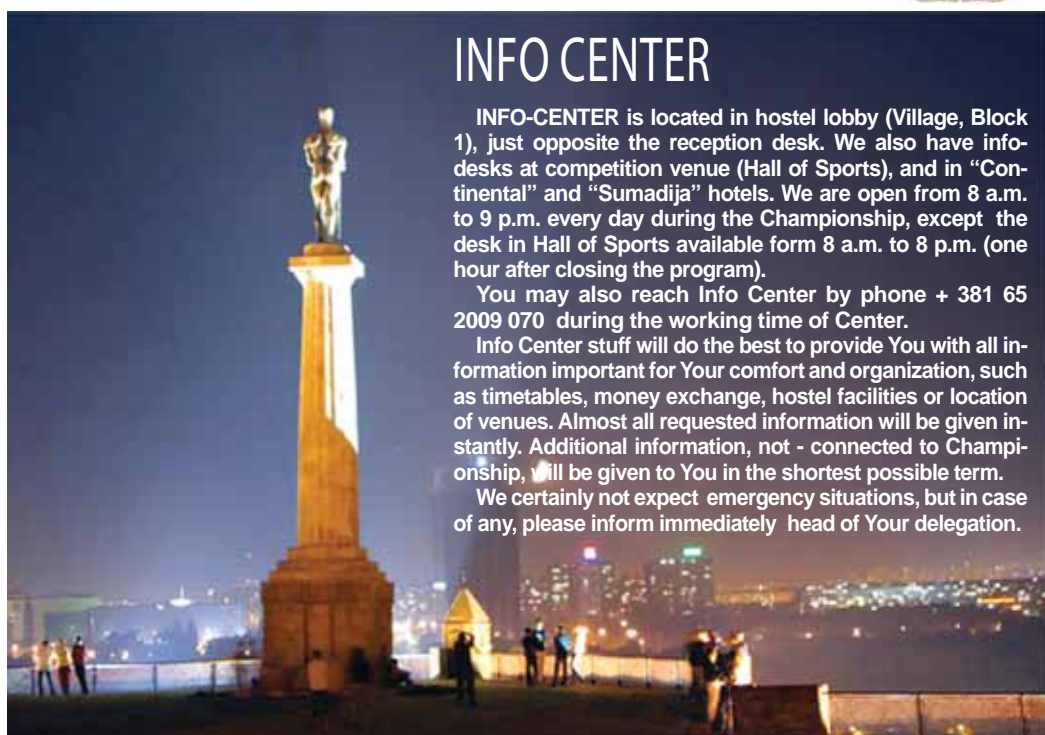


Belgrade is an unusual mosaic of civilizations that lasted many centuries, where everyone can find a little bit of what reminds them of home, but hidden in unique Belgrade's charm.

Belgrade is located at the crossroads of Eastern and Western Europe, on the Balkan Peninsula. It lies at the confluence of the Sava and the Danube Rivers. It is surrounded by rivers from three sides. Average altitude is 116,75 m above the sea level.

Belgrade is surrounded by two natural complexes: Panonska nizija (Pannonian Plane) with its grains and corn, on the north and Šumadija, with its orchards and vineyards, south from the Sava and the Danube rivers. The most prominent landmarks are the hills of Šumadija are Kosmaj (628 m) and Avala (511 m). Belgrade stretches south from the Sava and the Danube rivers, meaning this city extends over many hills. The highest point of Belgrade in the strict city area is Torlak (Voždovac), crkva Svete Trojice (Holly Trinity Church) 303,1m. The lowest point is Ada Huja 70,15m.

There is no similar place in the world where Oriental passion and European style are gathered in such a natural manner. Always caught between war and invasions from and between east to west, destroyed and rebuilt many times, Belgrade has no continuity of style. But it is widely enriched with vitality, a sense of humor and a cosmopolitan and inquisi-

SPORTS HALL IN NEW BELGRADE

As the oldest sports venue in this part of the town, Sports Hall has been developing a tradition of supreme sport clubs and A league championships since 1968. The Hall is originally named Palace of Sports, but is most widely known as the Sports Hall.

first concurred its worldwide popularity on the basketball floor of this Hall with the names of Kicanovic, Delipagic, Divac, Paspalj, Djordjevic and Danilovic still echoing in the air.

During the past seasons Sports Hall hosted judo tournament within European Youth Olympic Festival (EYOF), while every November it opens its doors to the local Belgrade Galeb Trophy, largest and most important taekwondo competition in the Region.
